Through April 30, Leila Alaoui's *No Pasara* is being exhibited at the Montreal Museum of Fine Arts. Alaoui, a young French-Moroccan photographer killed in the January 18, 2016, attack in Burkina Faso, used her photography to highlight issues related to migration, displacement and cultural identity. The photographer had been in Burkina Faso on assignment to do a report on women's rights for Amnesty International. The 24 images of *No Pasara*, which means "no entry," were commissioned by the European Union in 2008 and examine migration and cultural diversity around the Mediterranean.
