Baya Mahieddine exhibition coming to Sharjah

The must-see exhibition is a first for the region



For the first time ever in the region, the works of the iconic Baya Mahieddine will be on display in Sharjah.

solo exhibition that took place in Paris in 1947, along with over 70 paintings spanning her career of six decades.

"We aim to exhibit works by prominent established artists and explore their artistic experiences throughout their years of practice in celebration of their contributions to art history and to the development of Arab art."
